

## **GRADING POLICY FOR THE COURSE**

## 1. QUIZZES

Each of the 13 quizzes will consist of eight true-false questions (worth half a point each) and will be graded with 4.0 (A), 3.5 (AB), 3.0 (B), 2.5 (BC), 2.0 (C), 1.5 (C), 1.0 (D), 0.5 (F), or 0.0 (F). The worst 3 of the 13 grades will be discarded. The average of the remaining 10 grades will be your *quiz score* (a number from 0 to 4, usually not an integer).

## 2. TERM PAPER

There is a separate handout with the grading policy for the term paper. The paper will get a letter grade (from A to F), which will be converted to a number according to the scale used by the University of Wisconsin-Madison (A $\rightarrow$ 4.0, AB $\rightarrow$ 3.5, B $\rightarrow$ 3.0, BC $\rightarrow$ 2.5, C $\rightarrow$ 2.0, D $\rightarrow$ 1.0, F $\rightarrow$ 0.0). This number will be your *term paper score* (a number from 0 to 4, maybe not an integer).

## 3. COURSE SCORE AND GRADE

The average of (1) your quiz score and (2) your term paper score will be your *course score* (a number from 0 to 4, usually not an integer). This will be converted to your *course grade* as follows (scores at cutoff points correspond to the higher grade):

Note that the course grade will be F if you fail to submit the term paper.
